We say playnlye here, & so do lies of credite owt of frawnce, that the K. will not meddell with his brothers actyons nor with these contryes./ The P. of Orengs wound, was made nothing to the frenche K. by the repport from hence, to the end he sholld not be discorayged to joyne with his Brother.

Ytt is well conffirmed that the K of Sp: hath mony in Redynes att Gene & in Venyce to make his sowdyors marche, & that daylye grett Trowpes do arryve into Luxemburgh./
