The matters in ha[...] reason of the great personages cumen from the fr. k. to negocia[te] which are the Prince Daulphynne, the marshall of Cosseye, [misieur] le Carouge, monsieur La motte fennelo, monsieur de Pynnardo, [M...] monsieur le [Saisidente], monsieur de Vraye, and the Leggier, all[...] There dothe come to accompaynye thes, they yonge Duke of [...] his brother bothe nephewes to the yonge Prynce Daulphyne.
